Residents of the city of Upper Arlington will have an opportunity to make history when they share their feelings and opinions about the future of their community Wednesday, July 12th. Qube is proud to be a part of this revolutionary partnership between new communications technology and a city's desire for the best possible form of public involvement in the planning process.



Your Qube console is the instrument by which you make your opinions known.

The Planning Commission of the City of Upper Arlington has recently received — from consultants Trott and Bean Associates, Architects and Planners, A.I.A. — "The Old Arlington Study." Now the Planning Commission goes out into the community to ask residents for their response to the proposals and recommendations contained in this study. Public hearings at the Lane Avenue Baptist Church (June 22) and Jones Junior High School (June 29) precede the historic live two-way program directed from Qube's Olentangy River Road Studios. As in the case of the two preceding hearings, residents of the City of Upper Arlington can attend the meeting in person to speak to the members of the Planning Commission (see photo below).

Residents of the City of Upper Arlington can also choose to participate in the meeting from their own homes, using Qube's two-way response buttons. Qube subscribers who live in Upper Arlington are encouraged to invite their friends and neighbors to participate with them. Telephone lines will also be available for people to make statements live during this unique program.

This historic public meeting begins at 8:30 P.M. on Qube channel P9, preceded at 8:00 P.M. with the half-hour video tape explaining "The Old Arlington Study." This tape will be

shown throughout the first two weeks of July at conveniently scheduled times. (See today's schedule page, or your free TV program listing, T1.)

The Old Arlington Study. The Planning Commission of the City of Upper Arlington is appointed by City Council and charged with developing long range guidelines for the future of the community. In undertaking "The Old Arlington Study," the Commission concentrated on the southernmost part of the community. This is Old Arlington, the heart of the original community of Upper Arlington. In preparing its proposals and recommendations, the Planning Commission focused on several key aspects of the Old Arlington area: reallocation of existing facilities; realignment and widening of streets; improvement of intersections; and additions to recreation space.

You can prepare yourself for participating in the July 12th program by viewing the Old Arlington Study on C1 and C10 during the first two weeks of July. Or simply touch in at 8:00 P.M. the night of July 12th for the showing which will precede the actual program.
